Developed in the 1950s, the George Biddle Kelley Scholarship aims to award and acknowledge financially disadvantaged and underserved students from the Capital District, who are committed to the values of scholarship, and improving the lives of others in the community.

Available Scholarships: Applicants may apply for the General Scholarship and may be eligible for one of the additional specific awards:

- ➢ George Biddle Kelley General Scholarship
- > Dr. Elmer L. Green Scholarship for the Physical Sciences (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, etc.)
- > Leon C. Nelson Scholarship for the Social Sciences (Sociology, Economics, Political Science, etc.)
- > Dr. Twitty J. Styles Scholarship for the Biological Sciences (Biology, Microbiology, Immunology, etc.)

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for this one-time scholarship award, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- > Be a male from a traditionally underrepresented community in the Capital District
- > Be a current candidate for graduation from an accredited public or private high school in the Capital District
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (or 83 average)
- > Have applied to, and/or been accepted into, a degree program at an accredited four-year college or university
- Submit a completed application All participants must complete the General Scholarship Application (Part I)

Applications will be reviewed and considered based upon but not limited to the following criteria: documented financial need, living or working in diverse environments, exceptional leadership skills, scholarship, and a commitment to community service.

Application Process:

Submission of a completed George Biddle Kelley Education Foundation Scholarship Application consisting of:

- General information cover sheet
- □ Signed consent page by both the student and a parent or legal guardian
- 400-500 word typed essay Please follow the included essay guidelines
- □ Official school transcript in a sealed envelope

- Your essay will be judged on:
 - a. Creative content Did the applicant utilize a unique perspective or point of view?
 - b. **Idea Development & Focus** Was the idea developed to its fullest extent? Was the essay coherent and rational? Did the applicant remain focused?
 - c. Writing Style Includes format, spelling, punctuation, grammatical <u>and</u> typographical errors.
 Any grammatical or spelling errors will dramatically reduce your score.
